Private Events Coordinator Lisa Mitchell presented the following for approval:

- A. Octoberfest Addendum – October 19-21, 2012 and October 26-28, 2012 - presented by: Bob Rothermel, Special Event Productions/T.E.A.M. Productions

Council Member Cymek moved to approve the event as amended to allow (1) use of the ramp on the north side of North Division, (2) additional setup time on October 13th and 14th, (3) use of public works sand fencing and poles (4) public works to deliver, set up and operate sand auger (with an off-duty public works employee); seconded by Council Member Ashley. The vote was unanimous.

Council Secretary Martin moved to approve; seconded by Council Member Knight. The vote was unanimous.

ITEMS REFERRED TO AND PRESENTATIONS FROM THE CITY SOLICITOR

City Solicitor Ayres presented the following for approval:

- A. Second Reading – Ordinance 2012-27 to Adopt 2012 Building Codes (adoption of building and energy codes as required by the State of Maryland) **Council Member Cymek moved to ratify Ordinance 2012-27; seconded by Council Member Knight. The vote was unanimous.**
- B. First Reading – Ordinance 2012-28 to Amend Chapter 90 Entitled Traffic and Vehicles (to allow skateboarding on the Boardwalk, for transportation purposes only, during the same scheduled time that bicycles are allowed on the Boardwalk) **Council Member Knight moved to ratify Ordinance 2012-28; seconded by Council Member Cymek. The vote was 6-1 with Council Member Brent Ashley opposed.**

Council Member Cymek moved to ratify Emergency Ordinance 2012-29; seconded by Council Member Knight. The vote was 6-1 with Council Member Brent Ashley opposed. The Mayor concurred with the vote.

- C. First Reading – Ordinance 2012-29 to Amend Benefits Paid or Provided to Certain Municipal Employees (to change the health savings account contribution amount for employees participating in the high deductible health plan) **Council Member Joe Hall moved to approve the First Reading of Ordinance 2012 29; seconded by Council Secretary Martin. The vote was unanimous.**

- D. First Reading – Ordinance 2012-30 to Authorize the Purchase of Real Property Known as 718 Kelly Road (to acquire real property for the expansion of a wastewater pumping station) **Council Secretary Martin moved to approve Ordinance 2012-30; seconded by Council Member Knight. The vote was unanimous.**
- E. Resolution 2012-12 to Authorize the OCDC to Submit a Funding Application to Assist with Demolition Costs of a Downtown Business **Council Member Ashley moved to ratify Resolution #2012-12; seconded by Council Member Knight. The vote was unanimous.**
- F. Resolution Authorizing the Disposition of Surplus Personal Property (authorizes the sale by auction of surplus vehicles and equipment through Govdeals.com) **Council Member Knight moved to ratify Resolution #2012-13; seconded by Council Member Cymek. The vote was 6-0 with Council Member Joe Hall out of the room.**

ITEMS REFERRED TO AND PRESENTATIONS FROM THE CITY MANAGER

- A. Bid Recommendation for Uniforms (see Attachment B). **Council Member Knight moved to approve the award for Uniforms as presented on Attachment B; seconded by Council Member Cymek. The vote was unanimous.**
- B. Request to Sole Source Purchase IBM AS400 Hardware and Operating System **Council Member Joe Hall moved to approve the sole source purchase of IBM AS400 Hardware and Operating system from SPS VAR for the amount of \$36,768.93; seconded by Council Member Cymek. The vote was unanimous.**
- C. Recommendation to Appoint Hal Adkins to the Coastal Bays Foundation Board **Council Secretary Martin moved to recommend to appoint Public Works Director Hal Adkins to the Coastal Bays Foundation Board; seconded by Council Member Pillas. The vote was unanimous.**

COMMENTS FROM CITIZENS

Joe Groves said that being questioned by Council Members Joe Hall and Brent Ashley in the previous Regular Council Meeting was “inappropriate”.

Herb Pawlukewicz said the Northside Park Building needs more repair, and, suggested that the Coastal Highway speed limit should be reduced to 30 mph.

John Adkins suggested that the \$3.00 bus fare be suspended on Election Day.

Kenneth Kramer introduced himself as the Mayor of Pembroke, Pennsylvania.

Tony Christ asked the Mayor about he and Dennis Dare’s expense account.

Bev Furst asked the Council to initiate “Paint the Town Pink” for Breast Cancer awareness. Council Member Pillas suggested a proclamation from the Mayor.

John Medlin asked if purchasing card statements can be listed on the internet. Council Member Joe Hall suggested that City Manager Recor incorporate an awareness program in the Strategic Plan Initiative.

Council Member Knight mentioned the last day to file for candidacy is October 9, 2012 by 5:00 PM.



2012 Play It Safe

Play It Safe 2012 offered free, fun and alcohol-and-drug-free events starting on Thursday, May 31, 2012, and the excitement continued through Tuesday, June 19, 2012. Some points to note about this year's project are:

- ▶ **8,620** participants
- ▶ **23** States represented, plus the District of Columbia
- ▶ Poster/T-shirt Design contest was won by a senior, Paige Bush, from Parkside High School in Salisbury, MD
- ▶ 30,000 Passports to Fun were printed and distributed in Ocean City and Worcester County
- ▶ 50,000 informational brochures were printed and distributed across the State of Maryland and beyond
- ▶ 58 FREE planned events, including karaoke, indoor miniature golf, windsurfing, kayaking, midnight bowling, basketball, outdoor miniature golf, volleyball, Splash Mountain Water Sports Park, paintball, tennis, laser tag, rock climbing, pizza eating contests, dodgeball and 2 tye dye t-shirt design events. Two (2) events were cancelled due to rain in 2012.
- ▶ 300+ businesses, organizations and individuals contributed money and prizes
- ▶ 100 Volunteers gave 736+ hours of service for the implementation of Play It Safe 2012. This does not include the countless hours contributed by members of the Ocean City Drug and Alcohol Abuse Prevention Committee, Inc., as well as, time contributed by all of the agencies, i.e., Worcester County Health Department, Ocean City Public Works, Ocean City Transportation, Ocean City Police Department, etc., necessary for the successful implementation of the events.
