CALL TO ORDER

Council President Lloyd Martin called the meeting to order at noon in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 301 North Baltimore Avenue in Ocean City, Maryland; then, **Council Secretary Mary Knight moved to convene into closed session to consult with counsel to obtain legal advice; seconded by Council Member Ashley. The vote was 5-0 with Council Members Pillas and Mitrecic absent.**

REPORT ON CLOSED SESSION – TUESDAY, JULY 9, 2013 – 12:00 P.M. – 1:00 P.M.

Council President Lloyd Martin reopened the meeting at 1:00 p.m. and reported that legal matters were discussed in closed session. Persons present were Mayor Rick Meehan, Council President Lloyd Martin, Council Secretary Mary Knight, Council Members Doug Cymek, Brent Ashley, Dennis Dare and Margaret Pillas, City Solicitor Guy Ayres and Executive Office Associate Diana Chavis. The vote to close the meeting was unanimous with Council Member Mitrecic absent.

- C. Request Approval to Purchase Ammunition presented by Lt. Richard Moreck **Council Secretary Mary Knight moved to approve the partial ammunition from The Gun Shop of Vincentown, New Jersey for the amount of \$26,193.87; seconded by Council Member Cymek. The vote was 6-0 with Council Member Mitrecic absent.**
- D. Request to Approve Boardwalk Business Directory Signage by Glenn Irwin, OCDC Executive Director and Vicki Barrett, OCDC Boardwalk Committee Chair **Council Secretary Mary Knight moved to approve the Downtown Association's request to install Boardwalk Business Directory signage in the following locations: (1) Tram wall at S. 1st Street; (2) Caroline Street Restroom; (3 & 4) N. Division Street north and south sides of the archway legs; (5) 9th Street Restroom, and; (6) 27th Street tram building; seconded by Council Member Pillas. The vote was 6-0 with Council Member Mitrecic absent.**

UNSCHEDULED DISCUSSION

Council Member Margaret Pillas moved to direct City Staff to clarify the 20-Minute parking signage on 3rd Street, beside City Hall, by adding "Mon-Fri except Weekends and Holidays;" seconded by Council Member Ashley. The vote was 6-0 with Council Member Mitrecic absent.
