ORDINANCE 2012- 11

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 6, ENTITLED  
ANIMALS, OF THE CODE OF THE  
TOWN OF OCEAN CITY, MARYLAND

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF OCEAN CITY THAT CHAPTER 6, ENTITLED ANIMALS, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN CITY, MARYLAND BE, AND IT IS HEREBY, AMENDED BY REPEALING AND REENACTING WITH AMENDMENT SECTION 6-47, AS FOLLOWS:


Sec. 6-47. Limit on number of horses.


There is no limit on the number of permits that can be sold. There shall be a limit of no more than 12 horses permitted on the beach at any one time, except by waiver of such limitation by the city manager. Riding sessions must be scheduled at least three days in advance by contacting the City Clerk's Office at telephone number (410) 289-8221 and making a reservation. If 12 slots have been reserved for said day, then no reservation can be made for additional riders on said date without a waiver of the limitation by the city manager. Ocean City reserves the right to only allow riding during times when the ocean tide shall be the lowest.


INTRODUCED at a meeting of the City Council of Ocean City, Maryland held on February 28, 2012.




