ORDINANCE 2012- 12

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 102,
ENTITLED, VEHICLES FOR HIRE, OF THE
CODE OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN CITY, MARYLAND

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF OCEAN CITY THAT CHAPTER 102, ENTITLED VEHICLES FOR HIRE, BE, AND THE SAME IS HEREBY, AMENDED BY REPEALING AND REENACTING WITH AMENDMENT SUBSECTION 102-32(c)(12), AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 102-32. Requirements.

...

(c) ...

...

(12) It shall be unlawful for any taxicab to display, internally or externally, any advertising materials, except:

A. The name of the taxicab owner.

B. Advertisement on exterior roof light, which does not exceed 39"L, 14"W and 15"H in size, and which is not:

- i. False, misleading or deceptive;
- ii. Sexually explicit or obscene;
- iii. Violent in nature or illegal;
- iv. Promoting tobacco products;
- v. Promoting gambling, except for Ocean Downs or the State lottery and keno
- vi. Promoting alcohol products.
