ORDINANCE 2012-15

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE MORATORIUM ON BUSINESS LICENSES  
FOR CERTAIN MOTORIZED VEHICLES, WHICH ARE NOT  
STATE REGISTERED

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of Ocean City passed Ordinance 2012-4 imposing a moratorium on business licenses for certain motorized vehicles; and


WHEREAS, the moratorium is scheduled to expire prior to the Mayor and City Council of Ocean City enacting a new licensing ordinance for such vehicles.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF OCEAN CITY THAT THE MORATORIUM ON THE ISSUANCE OF ANY BUSINESS LICENSE FOR THE RENTAL OR SALE OF ANY MOTORIZED VEHICLE, WHICH IS NOT LICENSED OR IS NOT REQUIRED TO BE LICENSED UNDER STATE LAW BE, AND IT IS HEREBY, EXTENDED THROUGH MAY 15, 2012.


INTRODUCED at a meeting of the City Council of Ocean City, Maryland held on April 16, 2012.


