ORDINANCE 2012- 29

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BENEFITS PAID OR PROVIDED TO CERTAIN MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the City Council is authorized and empowered to provide for a retirement plan, compensation plan and employee benefit program for municipal employees pursuant to §§ C-1006, 1007 and 1008 of the Charter of the Mayor and City Council of Ocean City; and

WHEREAS, after hearing presentations from the town's Director of Human Resources and the City Manager, the City Council has determined it is in the best interest of its citizenry to make certain changes to the employee benefit programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF OCEAN CITY THAT THE FOLLOWING BE, AND IT IS HEREBY, ADOPTED:

A. Effective January 1, 2013, if an employee elects to participate in the high deductible health plan, Ocean City will contribute an amount to the employee's health savings account (HSA), which the employee can utilize to satisfy deductible charges and other allowable medical expenses, as follows:




ADOPTED AND PASSED, as amended, by the required vote of the elected membership of the City Council and approved by the Mayor at its meeting held on October 15, 2012.


