1. Have a current Ocean City Business license # \_\_\_\_\_
2. Apply fertilizers and pesticides in accordance with product label. It is important to know the rain forecast so application is not immediately washed off.
3. Test Soil to determine the appropriate application of fertilizer.
4. Do not blow or sweep debris into the public way or down storm drains or into canals. Blow/sweep debris back on to lawn or vegetated area. This adds nutrients back to the soil
5. Do not over water lawns. If water is running of to the city street the ground cannot take any more water. The discharge water must be free of debris and sand and meet all other requirements listed in the City Code in section Sec. 94-64 and Sec. 94-66
6. Have available all Material Data Safety Sheet for all chemicals, used in your daily operation. Knowledge of disposal procedures and Medical attention is vital. Attach to this form.
7. Insure all employees know of these BMP's and are using them.
