311.01 Purpose

To establish the necessary criteria and requirements for maintaining a Maryland Institute of Emergency Medical Services Systems EMS Affiliation.

311.02 Policy

- A. All members wishing to enroll in either an Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), Maryland Cardiac Rescue Technician – Intermediate (CRT-I), or Paramedic program must have all required paperwork such as the Affiliation Verification form and other program specific paperwork completed by the department's Training Officer.
- B. Beginning July 1, 2013, all new EMTs must successfully complete the department's Field Training Program upon completion of the EMT course in order to maintain their EMS affiliation with the department.
- C. Beginning July 1, 2013, all EMTs who wish to be sponsored and/or supported by the department while attending a CRT-I or Paramedic educational program must have successfully completed the department's Field Training Program as an EMT.
- D. All Advanced Life Support (ALS) providers who are affiliated with the department must successfully complete the department's Field Training Program in order to maintain their EMS affiliation with the department. This applies to ALL current ALS providers regardless of their time with the department.
- E. Upon renewal of Maryland licensure, all ALS providers must demonstrate proficiency through skill performance evaluations as directed by the department's Training Officer. This process shall include, but not be limited to, Patient Assessment-Trauma, Dynamic and Static Cardiology as outlined by the National Registry.
