MOTORCYCLIST FLOWN OUT AFTER CRASH

Ocean City Police responded to serious crash involving a motorcycle on Saturday night. Around 9:30, officers investigated a crash at 67th Street and Coastal Highway.

A motorcycle operated by 57 year old Joseph Stiner of Perryville, Maryland, attempted to turn onto 67th Street from the northbound turn lane of Coastal Highway. He failed to yield right of way and was struck by a southbound vehicle as he tried to cross Coastal Highway. The vehicle, an Oldsmobile Aurora, was driven by a 57 year old Ocean City man.

Stiner and his passenger, 57 year old Deborah Stiner, were both ejected from the motorcycle. Joseph Stiner sustained serious leg injuries and was flown by MSP helicopter to Peninsula Regional Medical Center. Deborah Stiner was taken by ambulance to PRMC with minor injuries.

The driver of the car was not injured. Stiner was listed "at fault" in the crash. This is the second serious motorcycle crash during the 2008 Bike Week in Ocean City.
