POLICE RECOVER MILITARY ORDINANCE

Early Saturday Morning, (September 27, 2008), Ocean City Police and Ocean City Fire Marshal's Office Bomb Squad, responded to two different areas of Ocean City, in reference to possible unexploded military ordinance.

In both cases, investigators determined the items to have washed up on the beach due to the recent storms. Members of the Fire Marshal's Bomb Squad have safely recovered both items and determined them to be unexploded U.S. Military ordinance. The devices were marked "Caution Do Not Touch, Explosive".

The Ocean City Police is advising people who discover any object that resembles some type of military device, whether in the water or on the beach to not touch or handle the item. Back away from the area and contact the police immediately. These items are unstable and dangerous.
