RESERVE OFFICER OF THE YEAR ANNOUNCED

The recipient of the Reserve Officer of the Year for 2007 was announced yesterday at the annual Reserve Officer Luncheon. The event, held at Seacrets Restaurant, acknowledges and pays tribute to the hard work performed by the many volunteers who give their time to assist the Ocean City Police Department.



This year's award was given to Reserve Officer Robert Borys. Mr. Borys joined the Reserve Officer program in 2005. Bob donated 339.5 hours in 2005, 379 hours in 2006, and 552 hours in 2007. In three years Reserve Officer Borys has donated 1,270.5 hours to the Police Department, and citizens of Ocean City.

During 2007, Bob volunteered 43.5 hours as a Domestic Violence Court Advocate, 300 hours working on Asset Forfeiture records, 40.5 working in the Criminal Investigation Division compiling crime statistics, 77 hours working in the Records Division and Human Resources, and 61 hours working Special Events including Cruisin Events, July 4th Fireworks, Springfest and Sunfest, and the New Year's Eve celebration at Convention Center.
