### OCPD K-9 INDY RETIRES

A member of the Ocean City Police Department K-9 Unit has recently retired after several years of service to the Ocean City community. Indy, a member of the Patrol/Narcotics Division, retired from the OCPD on September 20, 2009 after nearly 5 years of dedicated service.

Indy came to the Ocean City Police Department from Holland in 2004, at which time he became a loyal and courageous partner to Corporal Ronnie Townsend. "Indy has been the most loyal, hard working and dedicated partner I could ask for," commented Corporal Townsend. "He loved his job and he loved serving the Ocean City community and it showed through his work."
