The 26th Annual National Night Out was recently celebrated in two Ocean City communities. Ocean City residents, as well as several Ocean City Police officers, gathered on Tuesday, August 4, 2009, at Fiesta Park and Lark Lane for the festivities. The celebrations were sponsored by residents from Caine Woods and Bayshore Drive, however guests included residents from several Ocean City communities.

National Night Out is a unique crime and drug prevention event sponsored by the National Association of Town Watch. The program is designed to heighten crime and drug prevention awareness, generate support and participation in local anticrime programs and send a message to criminals letting them know that neighborhoods are organized and fighting back.
