OCEAN CITY WOMAN ARRESTED FOR ATTEMPTING TO OBTAIN PRESCRIPTION DRUGS BY FRAUD

On December 4, 2009, at approximately 4 p.m., Ocean City Police Narcotics Detectives concluded an investigation, in reference to a woman who was attempting to obtain controlled dangerous prescription medication using fraudulent and forged doctor prescriptions.

In cooperation with a local pharmacy, OCPD Detectives set up an undercover surveillance operation during which, the suspect tried to obtain the controlled dangerous drug by the use of a fraudulent prescription. She was immediately arrested and charged with attempting to obtain a prescription drug by fraud. The suspect has been identified as Tiffany Lynn Lamartina, 25-years-old, of Ocean City, Maryland.

Lamartina was seen by an Ocean City District Court Commissioner and held on \$3500 bond. Lamartina was transferred to the Worcester County Jail.
