OCPD ARRESTS FOUR NEW YORK MALES FOR BURLARY OF THE PIER AMUSMENTS

On July 14, 2009, at approximately 10:35 P.M., Ocean City Police were contacted by several employees of the Pier Amusements regarding a theft. Based on descriptions provided by these employees, police were able to locate the suspects only a block from the crime scene. The police investigation resulted in the recovery of various items of property that were stolen from Pier Amusements, which included t-shirts, stuffed toys and tools.

OCPD officers further determined that one of the four men arrested had committed a 2nd Degree Burglary the night before. In all, four suspects were arrested for various charges ranging from 2nd Degree Burglary to Theft. The men, all from New York State have been identified as:

All four suspects were seen by an Ocean City District Court Commissioner. Ellis-Jones was released after posting a bond of \$7,500. Dwyer and Marvin were released after posting a bond of \$10,000 and Wilson released on his own recognizance.
