OCPD REQUESTING PUBLICS HELP TO IDENTIFY BURGLARY SUSPECTS

On July 12, 2009, Ocean City Police responded to 107 Talbot Street, unit #2, in reference to a residential burglary. The stolen items included a Sony "Vio" and Acer Laptop computers, at least 7 credit cards, and various personal items belonging to the victims. Later in the day, Officers received information, that the stolen credit cards were being used at two different businesses located on boardwalk in the area of 6th Street. During the investigation police recovered several surveillance images from the 6th Street business, showing two suspects attempting to use the stolen credit cards. The suspects are described as:

Suspect 1- White male, thin, approximately 5'09" to 5'11", with sandy blonde or brown hair, wearing a black/dark navy blue and yellow striped polo shirt, light colored blue jeans, black sneakers, and a very large black pack.



Suspect 2- Black male, very tall, muscular build, medium length to long length dreadlocks, tattoos on left arm (possibly a cross), wearing a form fitting A-frame shirt, large black shorts, and gray shoes.
