TWO MEN ARRESTED FOR ASSAULT AFTER PLAIN CLOTHES OFFICERS WITNESS FIGHT IN PROGRESS

On Wednesday, June 10, 2009, Ocean City Police officers were on plain clothed patrol in the area of 18th Street and Atlantic Avenue when they witnessed an assault in progress. As plain cloths OCPD officers approached the scene to break the fight up, they witnessed the suspects, later identified as David Allen Burrows, 18, of Greensburg, PA, and Iszac Ternell Dallar, 19, of Delmar, PA, approach a man and strike him with an open and closed fist.

The victim subsequently fell to the ground and the suspects continued to assault him by kicking him. As officers got closer to the scene and identified themselves as Police, the suspects fled the area, one OCPD officer waited with the victim while the other pursued Burrows and Dallar. Shortly thereafter, OCPD officers arrested both men for assault.

Burrows was charged with one count of 1st Degree Assault and two counts of 2nd Degree Assault. He was seen by a Worcester County District Court Commissioner and was held on \$100,000 bond. Dallar was charged with 2nd Degree Assault and Disorderly Conduct. He was seen by a Worcester County District Court Commissioner and was held on \$50,000 bond.

The OCPD remind citizens that it has plain cloths police patrols in various areas of Ocean City as well as on the municipal buses. If you are involved in an illegal act, you risk being arrested and subsequently prosecuted.
