Following through with what you told us is critical and will affect your ability to return. Only once a full and complete assessment is made will a final recommendation be made to the Captain regarding an employee's status for the next season.

All letters will be sent out by April 1 indicating your final evaluation and status for re-employment. If you need to know your status before this time, you can contact HQ after November 1.

Reminder!

Make sure that you have completed and turned in all necessary paperwork, equipment, and/or provided the required official documentation before leaving.

Bring the following to Headquarters:

- Notification of Last Day Agreement
- Fall Employment Agreement
- Official Documentation of your Next Commitment
- All uniforms and equipment must be turned in by 8:00 pm on 9/25/11 if you are completing your employment for the season.

NOTE: THOSE WORKING BEYOND SUNFEST <u>MUST</u> TURN IN ANY EQUIPMENT THAT WILL NOT BE NEEDED BEYOND SUNFEST (UMBRELLA, ETC).
