Following through with what you told us you would do is critical and will affect your ability to return. Only after a complete review of the assessment process is done, will a final recommendation be made to the Captain regarding an employee's status for the next season.

Letters will be sent to those employees being invited to return around April 1. Only those employees receiving an A rating will be invited to return for the 2014 season.

The Exiting Process

Reminder!

Make sure that you have completed and turned in all necessary paperwork, equipment, and/or provided the required official documentation before leaving.

Bring the following to Headquarters:

- Notification of Last Day Agreement
- Fall Employment Agreement
- Official Documentation of your Next Commitment
- All uniforms and equipment must be turned in by 7:00 pm on 9/22/13 if you are completing your employment for the season.

NOTE: THOSE WORKING BEYOND SUNFEST <u>MUST</u> TURN IN ANY EQUIPMENT THAT WILL NOT BE NEEDED BEYOND SUNFEST (UMBRELLA, ETC).

A Note from Captain about the Marine Animal Rescue Program

If you trained last year on Monday, August 27, 2012, I am sending you an exam by email.

Although we had 45 people attend the training, Jennifer Dittmar, the MARP Stranding Coordinator, only had 8 paperwork packs with her. She sent the additional books and we attempted to distribute them at a Monday meeting last summer, but only a very few people remembered to pick them up.

What I need from you: Complete the exam that I send to you, and email it to Jamie Falcon.

There are two options that our personnel have. Both will provide OCBPSRA certification, so make sure you complete the requirements of the program you wish to participate in.

- OCBPSRA MARP certification only (required for OCBPSRA Instructor Certification).
 - You must have attended a full training: One was held back in Nov. 2011, another one was held on Aug 27, 2012, and another was held on November 3, 2012.
 - You must complete the take-home test and email to Jamie Falcon.
- National Aquarium "official" MARP volunteer
 - You must have attended a full training: One was held back in Nov. 2011, another one was held on Aug 27, 2012, and another was held on November 3, 2012.
 - You must complete the take-home test and email to Jamie Falcon.
 - You must submit a volunteer application
 - You must attend update trainings when available
 - You must be available in the Baltimore, D.C., or Ocean City area
