SWIMMING NEAR A LIFEGUARD COULD SAVE A LIFE! YOURS!!

Ocean City Beach Patrol Surf Rescue Technicians are back on regular duty beginning at 10 a.m. today and all swimming restrictions have been lifted. Due to the regular occurrence of Ocean City Beach Patrol personnel returning to other obligations at this time of the year, stands have been moved further apart. For your safety you should swim in front of lifeguards. For today only, we have modified the surfing ordinance allowing surfing along all Ocean City beaches. Swimmers always have the right away. Surfers must remain 100 yards from swimmers and must wear an ankle leash at all times. After today, the Ocean City surfing beaches will remain in effect.
