A Facelift!




The Ocean Bowl Skatepark received a face-lift this spring just in time to welcome extreme Dew Tour athletes to Ocean City. The Vertical Ramp and Pool are like new and received rave reviews from the visiting professionals (check out the skate scene on the Ocean Bowl's Facebook page).



The Vert Ramp is now a formidable 12 feet tall and 32 feet wide with 10 1/2 foot transitions and 1 1/2 feet of vertical. Its former steel surfacing has been replaced by new Skatelite Pro, the newest and best ramp surface material on the market today, and its transitions are clean and smooth.

The Pool, one of the park's most unique features, got a serious smoothing over with new perfectly molded transition slopes, new stone coping and tile all in and around a smooth 8 1/2 foot deep shell moving up to a 5 1/2 foot deep shallow end. The new user-friendly dimensions have been a huge hit with skaters of all ability levels.
