

This winter will begin her second season coaching the Sea Gulls. She is a graduate from the University of North Carolina, where she played two seasons for the Tar Heels. Mapp's greatest moment, as a collegiate student-athlete came on March 3, 1984, when UNC defeated North Carolina State, 99-76 to claim the first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference women's basketball championship in the program's history. She has served as an assistant coach at Temple University for four years, where she earned her Masters of Education. She was East Carolina University assistant coach and recruiter for three years. She spent five years as an assistant at North Carolina State, under the guidance of Hall of Fame Coach Kay Yow. In 2006, she coached at Princeton. She also served as the Athletes in Action team coach in 1999 that went to South America where they spent six weeks in Bolivia and finished with a 10-1 record.
