The Exiting Process

Reminder!

Make sure that you have completed and turned in all necessary paperwork, equipment, and/or provided the required official documentation before leaving.

The following paperwork should already be on file with Lt. Stone. If there has been a change, you need to update your paperwork.

- Notification of Last Day Agreement
- Fall Employment Agreement
- Official Documentation of your Next Commitment, unless you worked through the last day.

All uniforms and equipment must be turned in by 19:00hrs on 9/25/16 if you are completing your employment for the season.

NOTE: THOSE WORKING BEYOND SUNFEST MUST TURN IN ANY EQUIPMENT THAT WILL NOT BE NEEDED BEYOND SUNFEST (UMBRELLA, BUOY, BINOS, ETC).

We are holding three off-site tests in 2017: Sunday, February 12th at Salisbury University; Saturday, March 11th at York College in York, PA; and a test in early May at the Ocean Pines Sports Core pool.

Please continue to recruit potential candidates throughout the off-season.

Employee Evaluations – Not the Entire Picture

Although satisfactory evaluations are very important, they are only one aspect of each person's summative performance rating. Employee commendations, incidents, responsibility for equipment, amount of time worked, amount of time taken off, fulfilling work agreement, and last day worked are all considered by the review panel. Following through with what you told us you would do is critical and will affect your ability to return.

Only after a complete review of the assessment process is done, will a final recommendation be made to the Captain regarding an employee's status for the next season.

Letters will be sent to those employees being invited to return on March 30. Only those employees receiving an A rating will be invited to return for the 2017 season. If you need to know your status before this time, you can contact HQ after November 1, 2016.

Winter Mailings

Newsletters and all Return to Work information and notifications for the 2017 season will be sent to the winter address that you provided, as well as to the email address you provided this year. Updates and/or adjustments should be made through the office--either in person or by e-mail.



2016 W-2 Forms

The Town of Ocean City will send your W-2 form to the permanent address on record for you. This is the address that is printed on your paycheck. W-2's will be sent out by January 31, 2015. If you need to make any changes and/or adjustments, you must fill out a change of address form and submit it to the City Hall Human Resources department by January 1, 2017.
