- Hazard Mitigation Plan project for the Town of Ocean City has begun with grant funding and S and S Consultants working on the project.
- Ocean City Public Works and Emergency Management have completed the submission of the five year required updates to the Risk Management Plan (RMP) for the three Water facilities and one Wastewater facility. The Town of Ocean City has been completing all the requirements in-house at an annual cost savings of \$20,000.00 per year.
