Item	Page No.	Description of Change
1.1	Page 13 of original Bid Documents	In Section 3, Subsection 5.3, the Town is removing the minimum 70' reach requirement for the Aerial Bucket Truck.

### 2.0 – QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following questions and answers are provided as a matter of information to clarify issues raised about the Bid Documents.

Item	Questions and Answers
2.1	Was there a previous contractor performing this Work? <b>No. The Work being requested was previously handled by our Parks Department.</b>
2.2	Does the Town require a Maryland Licensed Tree Care Expert on the crew for all Work, even tree removal? <b>Yes.</b>
2.3	When removing a tree who will determine whether the tree needs to be topped or not? <b>The Successful Vendor must determine whether or not the tree must be topped for safety reasons.</b>
2.4	Does the Town actually need an Aerial Bucket Truck with a minimum reach of seventy (70) feet? <b>After further discussion, the Town has decided to remove the minimum height requirement for the Aerial Bucket Truck. Please take this into consideration when providing your hourly rate for the provision of aerial bucket truck with operator.</b>
2.5	Will it be the responsibility of the Successful Vendor or the Town to obtain any permits that may be required? <b>All permits will be the responsibility of the Successful Vendor.</b>
