WHEREAS, Homeowner finds that the Contractor is qualified to perform the work, all relevant factors considered, and that such performance will be in furtherance of Owner's business.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth herein and intending to be legally bound, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. MATERIAL AND LABOR PROVIDED

The Contractor agrees to provide all of the material and labor required to perform the following work for:

3. Labor Warranty

Coastal Comfort Inc. provides a two-year limited labor warranty. Equipment or system failure due to lack of proper maintenance service or abuse is expressly excluded. Normal maintenance check-ups and filter replacements are the responsibility of Purchaser. All other warranties, expressed or implied, are the responsibility of the manufacturer of the equipment, parts, or materials used in connection with the services.

4. Warranty Coverage

There are no warranties, expressed or implied, for existing equipment, ductwork, or other materials not installed by Coastal Comfort Inc. Coastal Comfort will register the equipment with Carrier.

5. COMPLETION OF THE WORK

The Contractor agrees that the various portions of the above-described work shall be completed on or before the following dates:

6. MODIFICATIONS TO THE WORK

7. ACCESS

The Homeowner, Homeowner's representative and public authorities shall at all times have access to the work.

8. CONFORMITY WITH DRAWINGS AND SPECIFICATIONS

The Contractor agrees to re-execute any work which does not conform to the drawings and specifications, warrants the work performed, and agrees to remedy any defects resulting, from faulty materials or workmanship which shall become evident during a period of one year after completion of the work.

9. INSURANCE COVERAGE

The Contractor agrees to maintain insurance to protect himself against claims for property damage, bodily injury or death due to his performance of this agreement. Coastal Comfort Inc. carries liability insurance and Worker's Compensation Insurance.

10. DELAYS

In the event the Contractor is delayed in the prosecution of the work by acts of God, fire, flood or any other unavoidable casualties; or by labor strikes, late delivery of materials; or by neglect of the Owner; the time for completion of the work shall be extended for the same period as the delay occasioned by any of the aforementioned causes.

11. NO ASSIGNMENT

Neither the Homeowner nor Contractor shall have the right to assign any rights or interest occurring under this agreement without the written consent of the other, nor shall the Contractor assign any sums due, or to become due, to him under the provisions of this agreement.

12. GOVERNING LAW

This agreement shall be interpreted under laws of the State of Maryland.

13. ATTORNEY'S FEES

Attorney's fees and court costs shall be paid by the defendant in the event that judgment must be, and is, obtained to enforce this agreement or any breach thereof.
