Requirements <u>No previous lifeguard experience</u> <u>or certifications required.</u>

 Complete a 400m run (offsite) under 75 seconds, or 300m soft sand under 65 seconds.
Swim 500m (offsite) or 400m (ocean) in less than 10 minutes.
Complete a series of tasks an SRT would be expected to complete, such as effecting rescues and moving a lifeguard stand.
Be 17 years old before you enter paid training academy.



What is a <u>Surf Rescue</u> <u>Technician</u> (Lifeguard)?

Duties include educating the public, warning swimmers of potential danger, rescuing distressed swimmers, responding to emergency situations, administering first aid, reuniting lost and found individuals, and enforcing city ordinances. The Beach Patrol is on duty every day from 10:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. starting Memorial Day weekend and continues 7 days a week (43.5 hours a week) into September.
