- .10 The Ocean City Police Department strives to provide protection for the personal and real property of the community's citizens; however, the large number of unoccupied and unattended properties and liability considerations prohibit any commitment or guarantee of special attention for specific vacant premises.
- .20 Upon receiving a request for attention to a specific vacant property, the member shall:
  - A. Record the address of the vacant premise, emergency notification numbers, date of return, and any other pertinent information on the vacant premises form, telling the caller that the Patrol Division will be informed of the vacant premises;
  - B. Notify the person making the request that the department cannot concentrate special coverage.
  - C. Enter the information for dissemination at roll-call.
- .30 The Patrol Division will attempt to cover as many vacant premises as possible on routine patrol.
