KNOW THE SYMPTOMS:

- Fever
- Coughing
- Shortness of breath
- In more severe cases, pneumonia (infection in the lungs)

NOTE: Call your medical provider if you develop worsening symptoms or have been in contact with a person known to have COVID-19.

PREVENT THE SPREAD:

- Wash your hands often
- Avoid touching your face
- Cover your cough
- Avoid crowded places & close contact
- Stay home if you are sick

KNOW IF YOU ARE AT HIGHER RISK:

- People aged 65 years or older
- People with severe obesity & diabetes
- People of all ages with underlying medical conditions, including: chronic lung disease, asthma, heart conditions, and other immune
