An Italian-owned company, US Wind, is attempting to get taxpayer subsidies and permits to construct 114 gigantic wind turbines just 11.5 miles offshore of Ocean City, Maryland. These turbines, which at 938' are four times the height of the tallest building in Ocean City, will destroy our ocean's natural beauty and natural viewscape. They will be clearly visible during the day and remain lit up all night long with blinking red lights. The sunrise off of our coast will never be the same!
Studies have shown that visible wind turbines reduce beach tourism and lower property values. My question to you and other elected officials is, why are we now allowing a foreign company to threaten Ocean City's thriving economy? Do you really know what the total cost of this project will be to taxpayers? Turbines of this size were never contemplated when the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management (BOEM) awarded US Wind's lease. Turbines off the coast of Virginia and North Carolina are 26 miles from their shoreline thus protecting the view shed for their residents and visitors. The threats to Ocean City's economy due to this project cannot be ignored.
In addition, Ocean City's commercial and recreational fishermen strongly oppose these turbines, as they restrict fishing, obstruct navigation, and cause false radar images. The wind farm also sits directly within the Carl Shuster Federal Horseshoe Crab Sanctuary, a crucial habitat for these species. Yet, there have been no studies to determine what impact these huge turbines and their high voltage cables might have on this important sanctuary. We must act responsibly to protect our environment.
This does not have to happen. It is not too late to say NO. For all of the above reasons, please instruct the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management to issue an unfavorable record of decision on the US Wind Environmental Impact Statement. End this unnecessary and wasteful project and save our ocean.
