- Position a lifeguard stand

What is a Surf Rescue Technician (Lifeguard)?

The Ocean City Beach Patrol is on duty every day from 10 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. starting Memorial Day Weekend and continuing through mid-September. Duties include educating the public, warning swimmers of potential danger, rescuing distressed swimmers, responding to emergency situations, administering first aid, reuniting lost and found individuals, and enforcing city ordinances. A typical work week is 43.5 hours with opportunities for additional duties.
