# Instructions for 2021 Beach District Mini-Grant Application

The Town of Ocean City is accepting mini-grant applications for Beach District Plants for a maximum award value of **\$150.00**. These plants are for *habitat enhancement, water quality improvement and erosion control*.

## Submission Rules:

1. Project sites must be located within the corporate limits of the Town of Ocean City.
2. Complete and submit the original application and the project site plan (at an appropriate scale showing planting scheme and total square footage of the planting area), plus one copy, to Gail Blazer, Engineering Department: [GBlazer@OceanCityMD.Gov](mailto:GBlazer@OceanCityMD.Gov)
3. The **deadline** for submission is **March 1, 2021**. The deadline may be extended if fewer than 20 grant requests are submitted by the due date. The grant will be closed after 20 complete applications are received. ***Any submissions received after this time will be put on a waiting list.***
4. Plant substitutions may occur due to wholesaler supply and demand.

## Mini-Grant Proposals Review:

Submitted applications will be dated and verified for completeness and eligibility. The Town of Ocean City will notify the applicant of the award by March 4, 2021, via email or phone.

## Receipt of Award Instructions:

**The wholesaler(s) will deliver the plants to City Hall late April to early May 2021.** You will be notified of the plant pick-up time, date and location. ***Award recipients must pick up plants within one week of notification.*** It is the sole responsibility of the applicant to install and maintain plantings. The Town of Ocean City assumes no responsibility for maintenance, or installation of plantings or replacement of dead or dying plant material.

Award recipient must submit a final report to the Engineering Department by May 31, 2021, including photographs and an explanation of the work completed. Some applicants may be asked to give a brief presentation at a City Council meeting or work session.
