1.0 – QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following questions and answers are provided as a matter of information to clarify issues raised about the Bid Documents.

Item	Questions and Answers
1.1	Does the City have the height of each of the outside camera which may require a lift or boom truck to gain access? This list will be provided in a future addendum.
1.2	Who is the current vendor and what was the value of the last contract issued? This information can be obtained by FOIA request. Contact the City Clerk's office for additional information.
1.3	For the additional Contingent pricing, is this per camera pricing or for the amount listed in the bid docs for that particular cycle? Per Camera.
1.4	Are Jail cameras part of this bid? No. No jail, Public Safety Building or Money Room cameras are included in this bid.
1.5	Is traffic control provided? No, vendor is responsible for traffic control.
1.6	Can vehicles access the boardwalk for this work? Yes.
1.7	Is the camera system managed locally? Yes.
1.8	Do vendors need to check for a live connection? No. Just report hardware issues.
1.9	Height of Baltimore Avenue cameras? Reference existing camera on west side of 30th Street and Baltimore Avenue

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

